

Keller Army Community Hospital has received permission to use the remaining allotment of our Pfizer vaccine to provide the COVID-19 vaccination to ALL community members.

Effective immediately, Keller Army Community Hospital's vaccination (first, second, or third/booster) schedule will be:

- Tuesday For adult population (ages 12 years and older). Appointments can be made on the COVAX Appointment Tool at <u>https://informatics-stage.health.mil/COVAX/</u>. Times available are 0830-1230.
- Wednesday For Pediatric population (ages 5-11 years old). The 'pediatric dose' of the Pfizer vaccine will be administered. For appointments, call the Keller Appointment Line (845-938-7992 or 800-552-2907, from 0700-1630) to schedule a vaccination time. Times available are 1300-1600.
- Friday For adult population (ages 12 years and older). Appointments can be made on the COVAX Appointment Tool at <u>https://informatics-stage.health.mil/COVAX/</u>. Times available are 830-1230.

The West Point COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic is located on the main/first floor in Keller Army Community Hospital, Room 1C20 – between the Pharmacy and the entrance into the Allgood Clinic.

As a reminder:

- In accordance with CDC and West Point Public Health Guidelines, face coverings must be worn at all times on West Point, including inside Keller.
- Vaccine recipients must present a Uniformed Services ID card or their DoD Beneficiary ID card at their vaccine appointment.
- The SECOND DOSE should be scheduled at least 21 days after the FIRST.
- The BOOSTER/3RD DOSE should be scheduled at least 6 months after completing your primary COVID-19 vaccination series (fully vaccinated).

West Point Public Health recommends you protect your whole family and slow the spread of COVID-19 in the Greater West Point community by keeping yourself and your children, ages 5 years and older, up-to-date on your COVID-19 vaccinations, maintaining hand hygiene and sneeze/cough etiquette, and maintaining social distancing when possible.
