

NOW IS THE TIME TO ACCESS THE MHS GENESIS PATIENT PORTAL

MHS GENESIS – the Military Health System's new electronic health record – is scheduled to be implemented at Keller Army Community Hospital on January 21, 2023. When fully deployed, MHS GENESIS will provide a single health record for service members, veterans, and their families.

The health record delivers data to healthcare teams wherever patients receive treatment -- whether it's at a medical facility within the Department of Defense, Department of Veterans Affairs, or the U.S. Coast Guard. This record will stay with service members from the time of their enlistment through veteran status.

- Verify/Update your information in DEERS. This will assure your information is correct in the MHS GENESIS Patient Portal and will limit delays or issues with claims, referrals, or delivery of home prescriptions.
- Access the MHS GENESIS Patient Portal at <https://patientportal.mhsgenesis.health.mil>. Create a free DS LOGON to access the MHS GENESIS Patient Portal. If you do not have a common access card (CAC), you will need to create a free DS Logon to access the Patient Portal. Follow the link to set up an account and once created, select “Upgrade to Premium Account” to view your health records.
