U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the NYS Department of Health are investigating a multi-state outbreak of cyclosporiasis, with nearly 470 cases reported across New York. This includes a dramatic spike in New York City and dozens across Long Island and upstate counties.

Because the source remains unidentified, the CDC urges the public to thoroughly wash produce, avoid contaminated water, and seek medical care for severe gastrointestinal symptoms.
